



- a) "Shipments of marketable dates in each outlet category", and
- b) "Shipments of free dates", and
- c) "Disposition of restricted dates" (currently there are no restricted dates)

If you have questions about the terms, please refer to Rule 987.162 of the marketing order.

2) Provide sales figures (quantity of dates sold and shipped) for the following categories:

- a) Domestic & Canada (DAC)
- b) Further Processing (FP)
- c) Exports – needs to be supported by USDA export certificate(s)
- d) Products – total of product grade dates sold ***plus*** manufactured products sold, see Form 6, Footnote 4. *Do not include pounds of dates converted into products during the month through the manufacturing process.*

"Manufactured Products" include:

- i. Chopped
- ii. Diced
- iii. Sliced
- iv. Extruded
- v. Macerate
- vi. Granules & Fine
- vii. Concentrate
- viii. Coconut Roll

- e) Exempt Sales – Handlers must have on file with the CDAC, Form 10 and for Producers, Form 9.
- f) Interhandler Transfer-Graded – refers to ***Grade Only***, has not been USDA inspected and certified.

- i. Sales or transfers made to other approved handlers
- ii. Graded, but not inspected, or Field Run fruit – should be supported by Form 1 on file with the CDAC.

g) Interhandler Transfer-Field Run

*Please note: Transfers of inspected and certified fruit between handlers should be included in "DAC", "FP", or "Export" sales figures of this part of this form.*

h) Culls – provide pounds disposed of as "cull" fruit during the month.
