Duplicate & Triplicate: Must be given to the party receiving the fruit. Upon arrival at destination the party transporting the fruit must turn both copies over to the party actually receiving the fruit; whereupon said party shall complete the Manufacturer section and mail to the CDAC. The triplicate copy is to be retained by the Manufacturer for record keeping.

Quadruplicate: To be retained by Handler authorizing movement of the fruit from its source for record keeping.

The making of false statement or representation on this form, knowing it to be false, is a violation of Title 18, section 1000, United States code, which provides for the penalty of a fine of \$10,000 or imprisonment of not more than five years, or both. This report is required by law (7 USC 608(d), CFR 987.51 and 7 CFR 987.151).
